As an assistant to musical figures such as Leonard Bernstein and Darius Milhaud, he gained valuable experience.

He has performed as a guest with the New York Philharmonic Orchestra, the San Francisco Symphony Orchestra, the London Symphony, the London Philharmonics and the Royal Philharmonics, the English Chamber Orchestra, the Orchestre de Paris and the Orchestre de France, the Vienna Symphony Orchestra, and numerous German Radio orchestras. He is also an experienced opera conductor and has conducted the Vienna State Opera, the Bavarian and Hamburg State Operas, the State Opera Unter den Linden, the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, and has also been a guest at the opera houses of Brussels, Zurich, Copenhagen, Toronto, Buenos Aires, Barcelona, and Stockholm. At the Dresden Semperoper, he has conducted Aida, Carmen, Madama Butterfly, La Bohème, and Turandot....
